- Camperships are available only to youth members who are registered members of the Greater St. Louis Area Council, Boy Scouts of America on or prior to June 1 of the year in which the campership is issued.
- 2. Camperships are available for week long. Camperships are not available for Dad & Lad, Mom & Me, Webelos Mini-camp or Cub Day Camp.
- Applications should be made by the Scout leader after all other means are exhausted.
- 4. Camperships are awarded up to half the camp fee.
- 5. Campership request should be made on Form 9801 and must include a brief concise statement of need. Family vacations, private education, and such are not considered valid reasons for assistance.
- Camperships are awarded after Camper Savings Day on May 1. Scouts who are awarded Camperships do not qualify for Camper Savings. If a Scout's request is denied, the Camper Savings will be extended upon request of the leader.
 Do not submit fees for Scouts with campership requests. No refunds will be given.
- 7. We recommend that campership requests be received by May 1. Scouts should participate in earning fees for summer camp.
- 8. The Scout must be attending a Greater St. Louis Area Council camp.
- 9. The application for a campership must be approved by the District Camping Chairman and District Executive.
- 10. The Director of Field Services or his designated appointee will approve Camperships based on fund availability and verify that the youth member who is to receive a campership is registered. Upon approval he will send a campership verification to the unit leader. There is no campership until these steps are completed.
